Docking:

Call "Westcoast Work Boat Association" on **CDN VHF 72** as you enter Ganges Harbour for docking directions from the Docking Committee

For boats using the Kanaka Dock: 20amp power is generally available

For boats using the Breakwater dock

There is only one 20amp power outlet available
